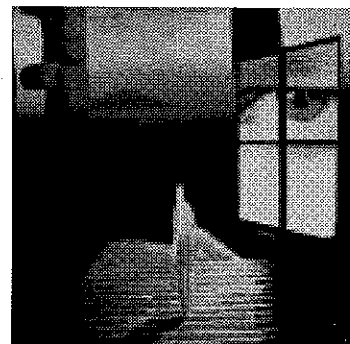


A degree which offers graduates many exciting career choices.
