There would also be some changes to the course outlines and descriptions published. I have consulted with other staff in the area and will also consult with Sue Rowley over possible very minor changes in name to a number or courses delivered by the School of Art History and Theory.

The reasons for this change at this time are many, and I list some of them below:

- Though not without international precedent (Hull Time Based Art, Time Based Art UCLA), Time Based Art is a relatively obscure term on its own, that is little understood by prespective students and other staff at COFA. Subsequently the area has become pratically 'invisible' within the School of Art simply because of the title of these courses.
- 2. The term Time Based Art was applied to these courses when the area was part of a larger School of Media Arts. Without this overall structure the term has become even more obscure.
- 3. The previous Dean of COFA was philisophically opposed to the term Media Art being associated with the Fine Arts, therefore it could not be changed by me before his time.

4. Other similar uses of the term include: the Media Art Academy Köln, the Dutch Media Art Institute, School of Media Art and Design, UCLA, the European Media Art Festival, Media Art Encyclopeadia (for video art), Media Arts, RMIT.
